CONSULAR LEGALISATION OF DOCUMENTS FROM HONG KONG TO BE USED IN VIETNAM

1. For Government-Issued Documents

- Step 1: Originals/photocopies to be authenticated by the Hong Kong High Court
- Step 2: Authenticated documents to be submitted to the Vietnam
 Consulate General in Hong Kong alongside identification for consular legalization
- Step 3: Obtaining a certified copy and a certified translation of the consular legalised document at the District People's Committee of Vietnam's Justice Division or a notary service in Vietnam.

2. For Non-Government Documents

- **Step 1:** Notarization of documents by a Notary Public or Commissioner of Oaths in Hong Kong
- Step 2: Notarized documents to be certified by the Hong Kong High Court
- **Step 3:** Notarized documents to be certified by the Vietnam Consulate General in Hong Kong
- Step 4: Obtaining a certified copy and a certified translation of the consular legalised document at the District People's Committee of Vietnam's Justice Division or a notary service in Vietnam.
